1. **Today, Saturday March 23rd, 2024 Father Philip Agu Spiritan Academy, Akabo closes for Easter holidays.**
2. **However, SS3 students will remain in school for the first phase of their extension classes and then vacate for one week Easter break on Tuesday, April 2nd, 2024.**
NB: SS3 Students return to School to continue with their Extension Classes on Tuesday April 9th, 2024; All should be in the FPASA Compound before 5pm.
NB: JSS3 students return to School for their Extension Classes on Saturday April 13th, 2024.

School Resumption Date:
